**A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT  
FOR THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

To re-appropriate Eighteen Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-Five Dollars and Thirty-Nine cents (\$18,865.39) allotted under Saipan Local Law 18-17, specifically under BUS Unit 4961P; and for other purposes.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION**

**PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE**

**COMMONWEALTH CODE:**

1 **SECTION 1. PURPOSE.**

2           The purpose of this Act is to re-appropriate Eighteen Thousand Eight  
3 Hundred Sixty-Five Dollars and Thirty-Nine cents (\$18,865.39) allotted under  
4 Saipan Local Law 18-17, specifically under BUS Unit 4961P.

5 **SECTION 2. RE-APPROPRIATIONS.**

6           Notwithstanding any provisions, statutes, laws or regulations to the  
7 contrary, the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation hereby re-  
8 appropriates the following amount:

9           (A) Eighteen Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-Five Dollars and Thirty-Nine  
10           cents (\$18,865.39) allotted under Saipan Local Law 18-17,

1 specifically under BUS Unit 4961P as follows:

2 1. Department of Public Works to install:

3 i. (6) 40' Secondary Power Poles, Total DX-g 1200'; and

4 ii. (3) Long Arm 150 WATTS HPS Street Lights.

5 at Lower Base, As Mahetog Area.

6 **SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.**

7 The expenditure authority for the funds under Section 2 of this Act shall  
8 be the Secretary of the Department of Public Works.

9 **SECTION 4. REPROGRAMING.**

10 Notwithstanding any laws, provisions or regulations to the contrary, funds  
11 appropriated under this Act shall not be reprogrammed for any other purpose.

12 **SECTION 5. FUND DISTRIBUTION.**

13 Funds appropriated under Section 2 of this Act shall be distributed  
14 accordingly to the intended purpose and or entity upon this Act becoming law.

15 **SECTION 6. FISCAL YEAR.**

16 The funds allocated under this Act shall be without fiscal year  
17 limitation(s).

18 **SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY.**

19 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any  
20 person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent  
21 jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to

1 persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be  
2 affected thereby.

3 **SECTION 8. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**

4 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as  
5 affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes  
6 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes.  
7 Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or  
8 pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of  
9 terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall  
10 already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.


11 **SECTION 9. EFFECTIVE DATE.**


12 This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its
