**A HOUSE RESOLUTION**

To recognize and congratulate Xenavee Pangelinan for her outstanding swimming performance at the 5<sup>th</sup> Micronesian Games.

- 1           WHEREAS, Xenavee Pangelinan dedicated herself to swimming competitively
- 2 beginning in 1993 for San Vicente School and has continued to compete for the Saipan Swim
- 3 Club since early 1994; and
- 4           WHEREAS, she distinguished herself as an exceptional athlete by earning 12 gold
- 5 medals in the 1998 Micronesian Games; and
- 6           WHEREAS, she further earned our admiration at the 1999 South Pacific Games for
- 7 winning seven medals, including one gold medal, and setting an SPG record in the 400m
- 8 Individual Medley; and
- 9           WHEREAS, through her talented swimming skills she earned a swimming scholarship
- 10 in 2001 to the University of Kentucky where she competes for her school’s swim team; and
- 11           WHEREAS, her outstanding performance at the 2002 Micronesian Games included
- 12 winning 10 gold medals, including seven individual events and three relays; and
- 13           WHEREAS, she displayed her domination of the sport at the Micronesian Games by

1 breaking six records: the 100m Freestyle, the 100m Butterfly, the 200m Backstroke, the 200m  
2 Individual Medley, the 200m Butterfly, and the 100m Backstroke; and

3 WHEREAS, her exceptional achievements were recognized through her selection as  
4 the 5th Micronesian Games Outstanding Female Athlete; and

5 WHEREAS, the people of the Commonwealth wish to proudly honor her for her  
6 accomplishments in the sport of swimming; now, therefore

7 BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives, Thirteenth Northern Marianas  
8 Commonwealth Legislature, that the House hereby recognizes and congratulates Xenavee  
9 Pangelinan for her outstanding swimming performance at the 5<sup>th</sup> Micronesian Games; and

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall  
11 certify, and the House Clerk shall attest to the adoption of this Resolution and thereafter  
12 transmit certified copies to the Honorable Juan N. Babauta, Governor of the Commonwealth of  
13 the Northern Mariana Islands; the Honorable Paul A. Mangloña, Senate President; and Miss  
14 Xenavee Pangelinan.
