



Dear Mr. Chairman and Mr. Speaker:

HOUSE LOCAL BILL NO. 20-53, D3

**A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT
FOR THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

To appropriate the CIP Bonds Accrued Interest Income collected for the Third Senatorial District in the amount of Two Hundred Forty Thousand, Five Hundred Seventy-Eight Dollars (\$240,578.00).

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION
PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1
OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:**

1 **SECTION 1. PURPOSE.**

2 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate the CIP Bonds Accrued Interest Income
3 collected for the Third Senatorial District in the amount of One Hundred Seventy-One Thousand
4 and Forty dollars (\$171,040.00) that has been identified by the Commonwealth Development
5 Authority as available for appropriation.

6 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.**

7 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the Saipan and Northern Islands
8 Legislative Delegation hereby appropriates the CIP Bonds Accrued Interest Income collected
9 for the Third Senatorial District in the amount of Two Hundred Forty Thousand, Five Hundred
10 Seventy-Eight Dollars (\$240,578.00) that has been identified by the Commonwealth
11 Development Authority as available for appropriation as follows:

12 (a) Sixty-Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty-Five Dollars (\$68,755.00)
13 to be distributed equally for the reconstruction and/or renovation
14 of the following basketball courts located in:

- 15 (1) San Antonio;
- 16 (2) San Antonio Youth Center;

- 1 (3) Dandan Children's Park;
2 (4) Faligulah (by Oleai School);
3 (5) Lower Navy Hill; and
4 (6) Kagman II
- 5 (b) Ninety-Two Thousand, Seven Hundred Dollars (\$92,700.00) for the
6 paving and/or repairing of Tasi Lane.
- 7 (c) Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) to be distributed equally for the repair
8 and maintenance of bathroom facilities at the following locations:
- 9 (1) Marine Beach; and
10 (2) Kili Beach.
- 11 (d) Twenty-Nine Thousand, One Hundred Twenty-Three Dollars (\$29,123.00)
12 to install 40' Secondary Power Poles and Street Lights in Koblerville,
13 San Antonio Village, Dandan, San Vicente, As Lito, Fina Sisu, and Obyan
14 Road.
- 15 (e) Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) for the repair and/or renovation of
16 the of the Agrigan Dispensary and Shelter.
- 17 (f) Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) for the maintenance and repair of
18 water catchment and tanks for Pagan, Alamagan, and Agrigan.

19 **SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.**

20 The expenditure authority for the funds under Section 2 of this Act shall be the Secretary
21 of the Department of Public Works.

1 **SECTION 4. REPROGRAMMING.**

2 Notwithstanding any laws, provisions or regulations to the contrary, funds appropriated
3 and earmarked under this Act shall not be reprogrammed for any other purpose unless through
4 legislative appropriation.

5 **SECTION 5. FUND DISTRIBUTION.**

6 Funds appropriated under Section 2 of this Act shall be distributed accordingly to the
7 intended purpose and or entity upon this Act becoming law.

8 **SECTION 6. FISCAL YEAR.**

9 The funds allocated under this Act shall be without fiscal year limitation(s).

10 **SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY.**

11 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or
12 circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this
13 Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it
14 is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

15 **SECTION 8. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**

16 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any
17 existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule,
18 regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect
19 any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not
20 have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which
21 shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.


1 **SECTION 9. EFFECTIVE DATE.**


