HOUSE LOCAL BILL NO. 20-17, D1

A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate funds specifically allotted to the Second Senatorial District under Public Law No. 18-30 as amended; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this Act is to appropriate Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00 USD) of the funds specifically allotted to the Second Senatorial District under Public Law No. 18-30 as amended, to the Office of the Mayor of Tinian a local public purpose and for the subsistence allowance for patients from Tinian.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.

There is hereby appropriated Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00 USD) of the funds allotted to the Second Senatorial District under Public Law No. 18-30, as amended. The Mayor of Tinian shall be the expenditure authority of the funds appropriated in this section. The funds shall be expended as follows:

a) For personnel, operations, public programs
 and contingency of the Office of the Mayor
 of Tinian and Aguiguan

(b) Monthly subsistence allowance of \$100.00
 per patient for dialysis, cancer, multiple
 sclerosis, debilitating epilepsy seizure disorder,
 dermatomyositis, arrhythmia, post cerebral
 vascular accident patients from Tinian
 \$11,000.00

SECTION 3. MANAGEMENT OF FUNDS.

The funds appropriated under Section 2 of this Act shall be transferred to an account set up by the Tinian Municipal Treasurer. The Tinian Municipal Treasurer shall regulate and control the funds appropriated under this Act so that no activity may spend contrary to this Act or fiscal management policies of the Municipality or the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.

SECTION 4. FISCAL YEAR.

The funds appropriated under this Act shall be appropriated without fiscal year limitation(s).

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.

If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 6. SAVINGS CLAUSE.

This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming law without such approval.
