

1 (b) Monthly subsistence allowance of \$100.00
2 per patient for dialysis, cancer, multiple
3 sclerosis, debilitating epilepsy seizure disorder,
4 dermatomyositis, arrhythmia, post cerebral
5 vascular accident patients from Tinian \$11,000.00

6 **SECTION 3. MANAGEMENT OF FUNDS.**

7 The funds appropriated under Section 2 of this Act shall be transferred to an account set
8 up by the Tinian Municipal Treasurer. The Tinian Municipal Treasurer shall regulate and
9 control the funds appropriated under this Act so that no activity may spend contrary to this Act
10 or fiscal management policies of the Municipality or the Commonwealth of the Northern
11 Mariana Islands.

12 **SECTION 4. FISCAL YEAR.**

13 The funds appropriated under this Act shall be appropriated without fiscal year
14 limitation(s).

15 **SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.**

16 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or
17 circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this
18 Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it
19 is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.


20 **SECTION 6. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**

21 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any
22 existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule,
23 regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect
24 any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not
25 have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which
26 shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.

1 This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming law
2 without such approval.


