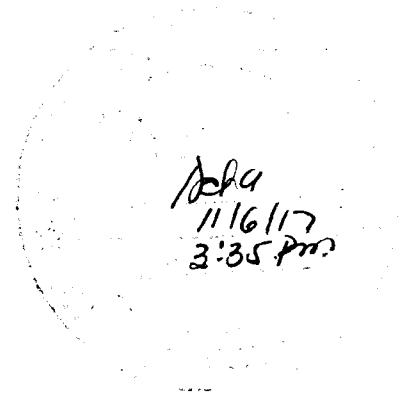

House Local Bill No. 20-41

**A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT
FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

To appropriate \$9,336.00 specifically allotted to the Second Senatorial District under Public Law No. 18-30 as amended; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION

PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1

OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 **SECTION 1. PURPOSE.**

2 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate Nine Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-Six
3 Dollars (\$9,336.00 USD) of the funds specifically allotted to the Second Senatorial District under
4 Public Law No. 18-30 as amended, for local programs and for other purposes.

5 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.**

6 There is hereby appropriated Nine Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-Six Dollars
7 (\$9,336.00 USD) of the funds allotted to the Second Senatorial District under Public Law No.

1 18-30 as amended, to the Office of the Mayor of Tinian and Aguiguan for personnel, operations,
2 and local programs.

3 **SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.**

4 For the funds appropriated under Section 2 of this Act, the Mayor of Tinian shall be the
5 expenditure authority.

6 **SECTION 4. MANAGEMENT OF FUNDS.**

7 The funds appropriated under Section 2 of this Act shall be transferred to an account set
8 up by the Tinian Municipal Treasurer. The Tinian Municipal Treasurer shall regulate and control
9 the funds appropriated under this Act so that no activity may spend contrary to this Act or fiscal
10 management policies of the Municipality or the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.

11 **SECTION 5. FISCAL YEAR.**

12 The funds appropriated under this Act shall be appropriated without fiscal year
13 limitation(s).

14 **SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY.**

15 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or
16 circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this
17 Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it
18 is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

19 **SECTION 7. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**


20 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any
21 existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule,
22 regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect

1 any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not
2 have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which
3 shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

4 **SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE.**


5 This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming law without
6 such approval.


