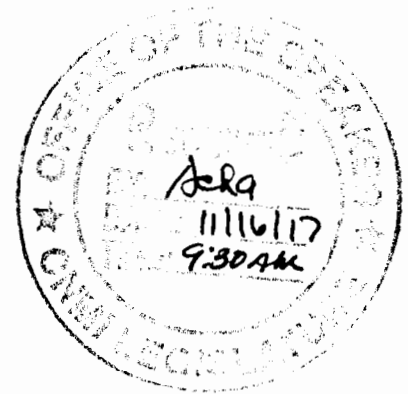

**A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT  
FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

To appropriate up to One Hundred Sixteen Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Nine US Dollars (\$116,469.00) of the Earned Bond Interest Income collected for the Second Senatorial District that has been identified by the Commonwealth Development Authority as available for appropriations; and for other purposes.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT  
TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:**

1 **SECTION 1. PURPOSE.**

2       The purpose of this Act is to appropriate up to One Hundred Sixteen Thousand Four  
3 Hundred Sixty-Nine US Dollars (\$116,469.00) of the Earned Bond Interest Income collected for  
4 the Second Senatorial District that has been identified by the Commonwealth Development  
5 Authority as available for appropriations.

6 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.**

7       Notwithstanding any provision of law, statutes, rules or regulations the Tinian and  
8 Aguiguan Legislative Delegation (TALD) hereby appropriates up to One Hundred Sixteen  
9 Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Nine US Dollars (\$116,469.00) of the Earned Bond Interest  
10 Income collected for the Second Senatorial District that has been identified by the

1 Commonwealth Development Authority for the expansion of the morgue at the Tinian Health  
2 Center under the expenditure authority of the Mayor of Tinian in consultation with the  
3 Commonwealth Healthcare Corporation.

4 **SECTION 3. REPROGRAMMING.**

5 Funds appropriated under this act shall not be reprogrammed for any other purpose.  
6 Notwithstanding any provision of law, all capital improvement projects funded under this Act  
7 shall be without fiscal year limitation.

8 **SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.**

9 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or  
10 circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this  
11 Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it  
12 is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.


13 **SECTION 5. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**


14 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any  
15 existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule,  
16 regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect  
17 any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not  
18 have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which  
19 shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

1 SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.


2 This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming law without  
3 such approval.
